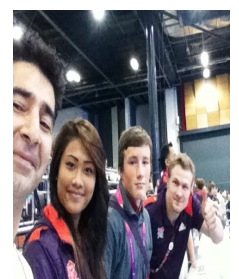
WE NEED

- British Youth 3 Gold, 2 Silver, 1 Bronze (British Champion team)
- Fulda cup 4 gold, 4 silvers and 5 bronze. (Second place in team)
- British Development u13/u18. 11 gold, 5 Silvers. (winning team)
- St Marys University British College/University championship became Champion 19 Lifters Coached by club head coach Kazem Panjavi and England team coach.
- 8 Lifters from Club participated in Olympic and Paralympics as Young Games Makers.
- 3rd Club Annual Competition held in Lampton School 36 lifters overall from 12 schools and university.



2013 CLUB SUCCESS SO FAR & AIM

- English championship 1 gold, 2 silver 3 fourth
- British school championship 6 gold, 3 silver , 2 bronze (club came second place)
- British student championship 29 lifters from club and St Marys University. Club– 4 Gold, 2 Silver, 2 Bronze and 6th and 8th. (St Marys became team champion, Stars for the Future came second place) Both coached by Kazem Panjavi.
- Female only competition selection for Grand Prix women only. Selected athletes– Shila, Poi, Noorin, Shonagh and Clara.
- Next competition British Youth 12 qualify lifters, two lifters from club hoping to qualify for European youth.
- London Youth Game, Coaching 5 Boroughs. Target take 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
